What are House Fires?

House Fires are welcoming gatherings where we come together in a relaxed environment to **seek** God, **build** community, and **grow** in faith. It's not a traditional church service—there are no pews, no pipe organs, and no pressure. Just real people having real conversations about faith and life.

What happens at a House Fire Gathering?

Each gathering is unique, but a typical night includes: Sharing a meal or snack together, Honest and open conversations about faith, Listening to a message prepared for the House Fire, Discussing the message and scripture, Praying for one another.

There's no pressure to speak, pray aloud, or do anything you're not comfortable with. You can participate as much or as little as you like.

Is this a Bible Study?

Not exactly. While we do read Scripture, House Fires are more about real-life conversations than a structured Bible study. It's a space to ask tough questions, support one another, and grow in faith together. Even if you don't know anything in the Bible, this is the place to learn!

Are House Fires connected to a church?

Yes! House Fires is a ministry of the Western States Conference of the Global Methodist Church, a network of congregations and faith communities committed to following Jesus and making disciples, and sharing God's love.

Where do House Fires meet?

We meet in homes and other comfortable spaces where we can share a meal or snack, pray together, and talk openly about our faith. You don't need to bring anything except yourself!
